Dear Magnolia Falls Homeowner,

At our last Board of Directors meeting, we were pleased to have representatives from Collier County Enforcement and Waste Management to discuss recycling with our members. Enclosed is a brochure from Collier County with what to recycle and what not to recycle.

Notice item #1. Remove food residue, which means that all jars and cans need to be washed. No leftover peanut butter, etc.

#2. Waste management would like to have the recyclables emptied into the recycle container loosely. They can be put in a paper bag, or a grocery store bag, but not closed. Any trash bags whether black or white that is closed will be treated as TRASH.

No Styrofoam or foam "peanuts", meaning the packing type of Styrofoam. Egg cartons and Styrofoam food trays are permitted.

Dog waste is not permitted in the recycling bins as the entire bins are then considered contaminated.

No motor oils or any paints are permitted, even latex paints are not acceptable. These and other unacceptable items may be taken to the recycle center at 2640 Enterprise Ave. West (Off Airport Rd) on Tuesday through Saturday between 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM. Any items that are placed outside the dumpsters will require a separate truck at an additional cost to the association.

We urge you all to comply with the recycling program in order to improve the quality of the environment, but to also save the association money.

Owners please prominently post the brochure for any renters.
