

## FALLING WATERS MASTER BOARD MEETING 4/24/2018

The president reported that there was a quick response and a happy ending to the emergency email requesting the owner of the dog that bit Connie Forcillo come forward. The owner reported to Connie that the dog did have its necessary shot, and she need not undergo a series of rabies shots.

The president also alerted owners to a potential scam regarding the safety of the drinking water in Falling Waters. An owner reported that they had received a call from a water purification company which claimed that Collier County had indicated the drinking water was unsafe, and the owner should purchase a purification system. The owner contacted Collier County which confirmed our drinking water is safe. Please be aware of this potential scam should you receive a similar phone call.

Ron DiFabio provided the treasurer's report for Frank Remyn who was unable to attend due to illness. He confirmed that Falling Waters is within its annual budget year-to-date. (Note: Frank is feeling much better as of today).

Jim Winchester gave a report for the Communication's Committee. The Splash will continue to be published with Tom Lennon as editor. He encouraged volunteers to work with Tom to gather community information for the next edition. (Note: I encourage volunteers to come forward. Tom is an unpaid volunteer. He cannot do the Splash by himself. He needs assistance from the community)

Roe Pellegrino gave a report on outside activities. Please check the Falling Waters web site for more information.

Marty Sinco gave a report on inside clubhouse activities which have been planned for the next several months, including a Memorial Day get-together at the Clubhouse.

The Master Board voted to seek bids for our pool management. The Board has a duty to periodically review services, costs, contracts and agreements with its vendors. The Board will select from among three bidders.

The Board voted to have meters installed on all Falling Water fountains. It has experienced problems with the fountains during the past year. The meters will enable the Board to identify problems and leakage.

Note: BELFOR continues to schedule repair work for Falling Waters. The front gate and wall area repairs are requiring several permits from Collier County for the work to begin. They await those permits.

Many of you have left Falling Waters for “parts north” in the past couple of weeks. Enjoy your summer and have a safe return to Falling Waters.
