

President's Message – Email Blast - April 15, 2020

As a mother, grandmother, sister, and friend, COVID-19 has affected every part of my life. I know this is the same for each of you. We are all anxious to get back to 'normal'. The truth is the normal we remember will be changed and a new normal will emerge.

On April 1, Governor DeSantis signed Executive Order 20-91 which outlines the stay-at-home policy for all Floridians. The order took effect April 3 and will last until April 30, unless extended. The order places a limit on the travel of all Florida citizens – travel only for essential services and activities. The order also appears to restrict senior citizens and individuals with significant underlying medical conditions from leaving their homes only to obtain or provide essential services or to conduct essential activities.

We are fortunate that to-date there have been NO reports of any positive tests or cases of coronavirus in the Falling Waters community. We are told to **KEEP DOING WHAT WE ARE DOING. OUR ACTIONS ARE WORKING** to reduce the spread of the virus and flatten the curve and save lives.

Management and the Board of Directors of the Master Association will continue the prudent measures to protect the residents of the Falling Waters.

FALLING WATERS POOL/TENNIS/BOCCE – CLOSURE EXTENDED

The pool, tennis, and bocce will remain closed until April 30, 2020. The board is discussing how these amenities might be reopened while continuing to meet the CDC guidelines.

FALLING WATERS CLUBHOUSE

The Falling Waters clubhouse remains **accessible from 10am – 1pm every day**. Use your **proximity card for access**. Social Distancing and appropriate CDC guidelines are expected to be observed when in the clubhouse.

FALLING WATERS MEMBER CENTER – DAYS REDUCED

The Falling Waters Member Center days have been reduced. Effective this week and until further notice, the Member Center will **only be open Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 10 A.M. to 1 P.M.** to facilitate the issuance of barcodes and to resolve related problems. Please maintain social distancing when in the Member Center.

Due to the extension of Executive Order 20-87 Vacation Rental Closure, there are fewer applications being processed. Only annual rentals or rentals for 30 or more days can check into Falling Waters.

Everyone is encouraged to continue to turn to the CDC and other qualified health professionals as their primary source of information and guidance regarding the coronavirus.
