

To all Owners and Residents,

**WHAT:**

As of Friday, September 23rd, there was an increasing chance that Tropical Depression TD9 will develop into a strong hurricane in the Gulf of Mexico. Intensity models show a possible major storm with a formation chance of 90% through the next 48 hours.

**WHEN:**

Impacts for Southwest Florida are expected to begin Monday evening (September 26th) into Wednesday morning (September 28th).

**ACTION FOR OWNERS AND RESIDENTS:**

1. Bring in all furniture on open balconies. Injuries and damage are routinely caused by objects left on balconies. For the safety of people and property, it is strongly encouraged that owners ensure that nothing can become a flying or falling object during an extreme weather event. Your Management Company is not responsible for removing or storing personal items left out.
2. Hurricane shutters must be closed and secured.
3. Continue to monitor the situation via the Weather Channel or local channels.

If you have renters or guests staying in your unit, please inform them of what action(s) need to be taken.
