Dear Homeowners of Rosewood,

**This message is sent as a friendly reminder notice!**

**Recently Rosewood and other areas in the community have been experiencing seeing rodents, particularly around the area of the dumpsters. Please remember to dispose of your trash in a tight tied bag or container, especially trash containing fish. Do not leave bags on the floor in the dumpster area which could attract rodents or any other wild critter roaming at night.**

**We already have taken measures with a rodent exterminator in the areas that recently were affected, however that may not have been necessary if trash were not left on the ground in the dumpster area. Also, please do not leave the lid of the dumpster open. On several occasions it was noticed that who ever lifts the lid fails to put it back down. The doors should also be closed when finished.**

**Please also remember not to feed any stray animal or the ducks. Leaving food on the ground anywhere for any reason will attract undesirable critters. An Extermination Program is costly.**

**With regard to recyclables, if the bins are full, please throw it in the dumpster, regardless of what it is. Do not leave it on the ground as Waste Management will not pick it up. Please read the rules posted on all the dumpster doors and abide by them.**
